Treasurer's Report:

Superintendent's Report:

Mr. Montgomery was very happy with the Talent Show and Donuts with Dads. Great attendance for both and very well received. He made the suggestion to take a free will donation for next year's Talent Show.

Activity Report:

- Talent Show: Went from 7-8:15. There were 16 acts, 60 performers and 250-300 guests. Several 8th graders helped to pop popcorn and served the refreshments. The 7th inning stretch was a great idea.

Middle School Activities:
